

“Falcon” Wall of Fame Eligibility

Nominations for the NW “Falcon” Wall of Fame can be made from the following three categories:

- NW alumni,
- NWCS D educators, community contributors, or benefactors, *or*
- Contributors to the NWCS D’s communities, institutions, governments, families, etc.

Nomination Process

Individuals may nominate alumni, staff and residents of NWCS D. Nomination forms can be found on the NWCS D website, www.nwcsd.k12.ny.us, or at the Administration Building, 5700 West Street, Sanborn. The nomination form will include a statement giving the accomplishments of the candidate. Supporting documents may be attached to the nomination form.

Nominee’s contributions and achievements must be significant. They can be from the following criteria:

Education/Academics

Those who have excelled in graduate/post graduate education. Those who have achieved scholarly positions, awards, or research which have impacted their chosen discipline. Those who have excelled in vocational education. Those NWCS D employees who have positively impacted students to achieve excellence.

Leadership/Quality of Life

Those who have demonstrated leadership in distinguished conduct, creating improvements in the quality of life for others via their activities, influences, and achievements in business, military, entertainment, sports, music, arts, literature, science, medicine, politics, government, environmental causes, religious service, social work, etc.

Community Service

Those who have spent their lives serving others via charities, religious organizations, government, families, service groups, volunteer organizations, the arts, cultural activities, historical preservation, environmental causes, etc.

Philanthropy

Those who have given their time, wealth, and skills to enhance the NWCS D community and the world in general.

Nominations will always be available. For the 2022 induction, the nominations must be submitted by May 1, 2022. Nominations will remain with the “Falcon” Award Committee for three years.
